## Project SEARCH Requirements

**Age & Education:** At least 18 years old, in their final year of school, on an IEP, and having completed all high school credit requirements.

**Disability:** Identified intellectual/developmental disability or autism.

**Employment Goal:** A strong desire and commitment to work competitively in the community after the program.

**Self-Sufficiency:** Independent personal hygiene, grooming, and daily living skills.

**Behavioral Skills:** Ability to take direction, accept feedback, maintain appropriate social skills, and communicate effectively.

**Vocational Rehab:** Must be eligible for Vocational Rehabilitation (VR)
